River Valley Relay Marathon

River Valley Athletic Club has announced the launch of the 1st annual “River Valley Relay Marathon” which is being run in support of “Strong Minds, Strong Bodies, & Strong Community”.

The River Valley Relay Marathon will take place Saturday, May 1st, at The Browns Creek Park Reserve in Stillwater. This marathon is a relay race run by teams. A team can have as few as 2 people, or up to a maximum of 8 people. Each team needs to have a captain. The captain will register their team for the marathon at either the www.rivervalleyathleticclub.com, or in person at River Valley Athletic Club 1826 Northwestern Avenue, Stillwater.

Marathon teams get to select where to direct their contribution from amongst the following local organizations: United Way (UWWCE), Valley Outreach, Family Means, Courage Center, Art Reach Alliance, Stillwater Parks, or the Stillwater Public Library Foundation.

All proceed from this event will go back to community minded non-profit organizations in the Stillwater area. The cost of the event is \$30 per participant. A 2 person team will be \$60, and an 8 person team will be \$240. To guarantee your shirt for race day, you must pre-register for the race by April 1st at www.rivervalleyathleticclub.com.

Place: Browns Creek-middle of the park

Distance: 100 yard dash (not a relay)

Cost: \$10/child
