RVAC Childcare Center Guidelines

Welcome to the RVAC Childcare Center. It is our goal to provide a safe and caring environment for children to play and learn. We look forward to caring for your child.

Member Guidelines:

- Free to those with a family membership, otherwise the cost is \$5 for one child and \$2 for each additional child.
- Children 6 weeks to 12 years of age are welcome to visit.
- There is a two hour time limit for each child each day, (1 hour limit on infants).
- Reservations are required for all infants under one year of age.
- Reservations can be made up to one week in advance but no less than an hour before.
- In order to accommodate all members, reservations must be cancelled at least two hours prior.
- RVAC reserves the right to remove or suspend any children perceived as an endangerment to themselves or others.
- RVAC reserves the right to limit the uses or usage of designated play areas.
- Parents or legal guardians must remain in the club at all times.
- Check-in and check-out must be done by the same parent unless a release form is signed and then only with proper identification.
- No food, gum or candy is allowed. If your child needs a snack you may take them into another room to do so.
- Parents will be contacted if their child cannot be comforted from crying after 15 minutes.
- Please label all cups, diaper bags, bottles, etc that you bring to the center
- Toys from home are not allowed, however, labeled comfort items such as blankets, pacifiers and stuffed animals are permitted.
- Members are asked to abide by our sick child policies.
- RVAC is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- RVAC reserves the right to suspend childcare privileges from anyone who consistently neglects the above guidelines.

RVAC Sick Child Policy

If a child becomes sick while at the center, the child must be isolated from other children and removed from the center immediately. Please understand that we are watching out for all of the children and don't be offended if we ask you to remove your child. A child with any of the following is considered a sick child and must be excluded from our facilities:

- A reportable illness or condition that a physician determines has not had sufficient treatment to reduce risk to others.
- Chicken pox until the child is no longer infectious and until the lesions are completely crusted over.
- Has vomited within the last 24 hours.
- Has contagious Conjunctivitis (pink eye) or pus draining from the eye.
- Has a bacterial infection such as strep throat or impetigo and has not completed 24 hours of antimicrobial therapy.
- Has unexplained lethargy.
- Has lice, ringworm or scabies that is untreated and contagious to others.
- Has a temperature of 99 degrees F or higher.
- Has an undiagnosed rash or a rash attributed to a contagious illness or condition.
- Has significant respiratory distress (a bad cough).
- Requires more care that the program staff can provide without compromising the care and safety of other children.
- Profusely runny nose with either green or clear mucus.

If your child exhibits any of these symptoms, please keep them at home for sanitary reasons, and for the safety and well being of the children and staff.
